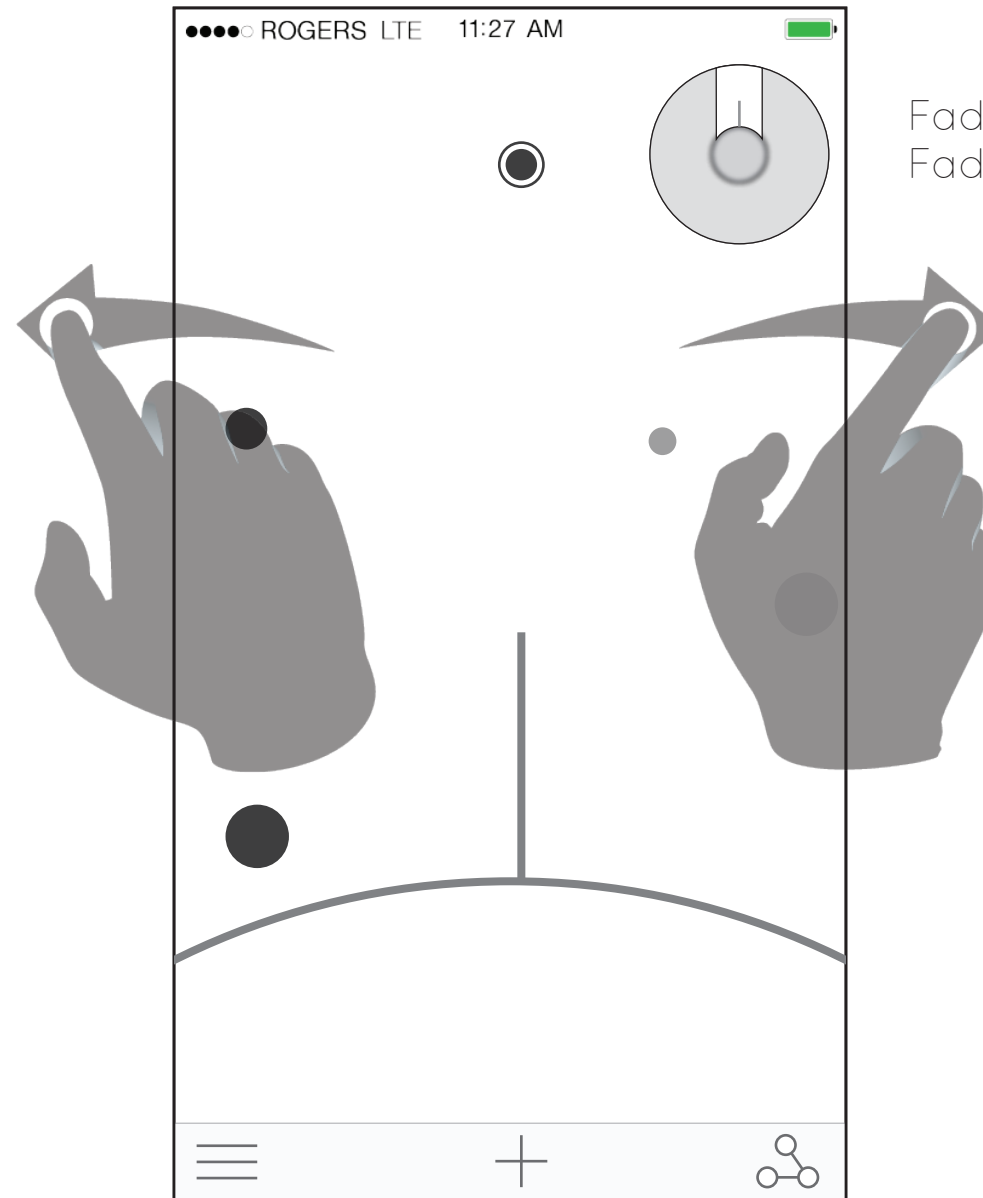
Home Screen



When an dot reaches the 'now line' it pulses for the length of the event. Once done it fades away.

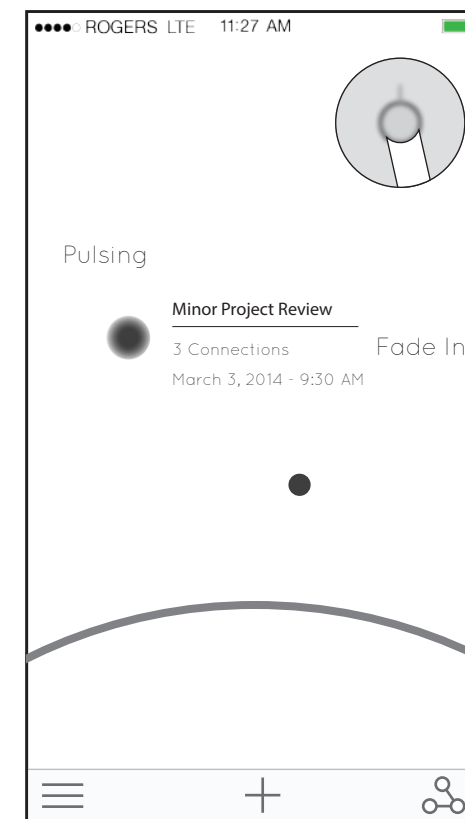
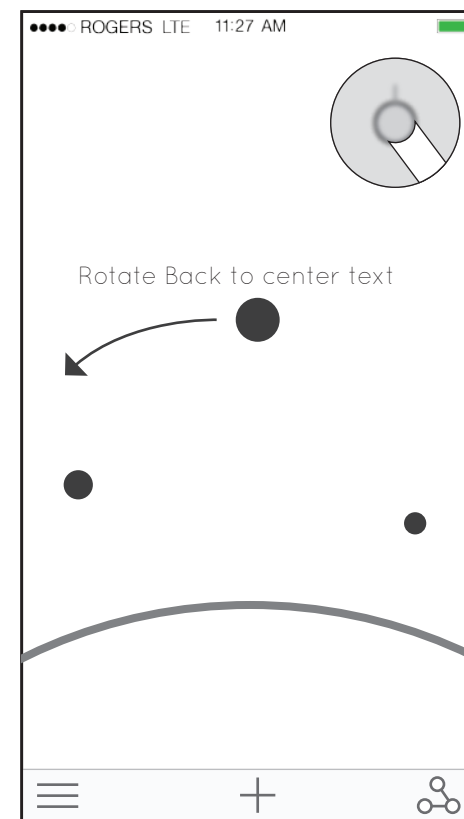
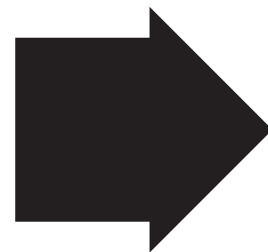
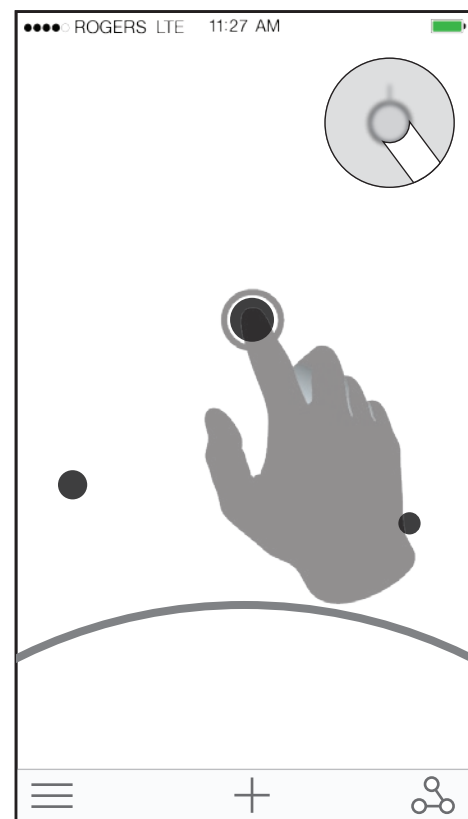
